7. PRESENTATION: SCSD Technology by Anthony Winstead

Anthony Winstead gave a presentation to the Board detailing who the tech department is, what they provide to students and staff, the major accomplishments that the department has been able to achieve this school year, the steps they have taken to distribute electronic materials to assist with distance learning, the future needs of the department, and the options they are looking at for students returning to school in the fall.

8. PRESENTATION: SCSD Transportation by Sandy Karppinen

Sandy Karppinen gave a presentation to the Board detailing the fleet of vehicles that make up the transportation department, how she has worked over the last 5 years since taking over the position to make changes to the bus garage to comply with OSHA requirements, how her department has worked with principals at each of the schools to drastically lower rates of student misbehavior on buses, the future needs of the department, and gave an update on how the transportation department has collaborated with the food service department to deliver food to children during the mandatory school closure, and how the DOL, governor of WA, and OSPI are collaborating to find a solution on how to transport students safely once students begin to attend classes in buildings again.
