EVALUATION OF THE BOARD

Annually, in June, the Board shall evaluate its own performance in terms of generally-accepted principles of successful Board operations and in relation to its annual goals and objectives. The Board self-evaluation shall address performance in the key functions of school Boards – vision, structure, accountability, and advocacy. The results of the self-evaluation shall be used in setting goals for the subsequent year. The Board, at its discretion, may choose to use policy form 1820F for this purpose.
