#### **USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES**

## **CATEGORIES OF USERS**

I. Youth-related and school-related, Not-For-Profit organizations, and local government and junior taxing district groups:

### **Examples:**

- School or District-related organizations such as Boosters, PTA, Senior Parents Organization, SCSD Foundation, and alumni groups
- Organizations that provide classes/services/activities for youths such as-athletics, cultural, educational or similar activities, and groups from other schools
- Community youth groups or organizations such as Scouts, 4-H, and church youth groups
- Local government and taxing districts such as the Sheriff's Department, Fire Districts, and Facilities and Recreation Departments (for official department functions)
- II. District Resident and Community Organizations

### Examples:

- Religious and community organizations such as church groups, service organizations, and Toastmasters
- Private functions such as reunions, receptions, benefits, and memorials
- III. Non-Resident Individuals or Organizations (Non-Commercial)

This category is an image of Category II, except for individuals or groups outside of District residential boundaries.

#### IV. Commercial

This category is designed for any individual or group wishing to use a District facility for an activity to make a profit.
