
TRAFFIC SAFETY EDUCATION

The District may provide traffic safety instruction during non-school hours for eligible students. A fee shall be assessed to cover those costs.

The Board directs the superintendent to implement procedures dealing with program supervision; curriculum development; student enrollment criteria, including but not limited to grade level of student, age of student, and enrollment status of student; student progress; and collection and refunding of student fees.
